

Minutes of a Regular Council Meeting of the
Village of Walton Hills, Ohio held Tuesday
April 21, 2015 at 6:10 p.m. in the
Village Hall Council Chambers at 7595 Walton Road

Mayor Hurst called the meeting to order and then led the Pledge of Allegiance. This was followed by a moment of silence for our military men and women and deceased residents Jeannette Singer, Carol Yelenoski and Mary Jane Pike. The roll call was taken by Vic Nogalo. Councilpersons present were Denny Linville, Mary Brenner-Miller, Paul Rich, Gloria J. Terlosky, Don Kolograf and Brian Spitznagel. Also present were Vic Nogalo, Fiscal Officer and Blair Melling, Solicitor.

Councilman Kolograf motioned to approve the regular Council meeting minutes of March 17, 2015, seconded by Councilwoman Terlosky, and six ayes approved. Councilman Spitznagel motioned to receive and file the Council Caucus minutes of April 21, 2015 seconded by Councilwoman Brenner-Miller, and six ayes approved.

PERSONS HAVING BUSINESS BEFORE COUNCIL: None

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Hurst reported that the Mayor's Court receipts for 2015 through the month of March amounted to \$74,876; he noted at this time last year the receipts totaled \$63,426. He announced that a letter was sent to all residents that would be most directly affected by the controlled burn taking place before May 15th.

LEGISLATION:

Resolution No. 2015-15, a Resolution authorizing the Mayor and the Chief Fiscal Officer to apply for an Ohio Department of Natural Resources Nature Works Grant for use on improvements to T.G. Young Park, and declaring an emergency, was introduced for suspension by Councilman Rich, seconded by Councilwoman Brenner-Miller. Mayor Hurst provided more detail on the Nature Works Grant and gave an update on the Cleveland Indians Grant. Councilman Rich motioned to adopt Resolution No. 2015-15, seconded by Councilman Spitznagel, and six ayes approved.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS: Mayor Hurst announced that there will be an observance of the National Day of Prayer on May 7th at 11 a.m. at the Prevailing Church. He also announced that there will be a C.O.W. meeting on May 5th and he is planning on having an Executive Session in May to address a couple of different items.

Councilwoman Brenner-Miller motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Linville, and six ayes approved. The meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
