

Minutes of a Special Council of the
Village of Walton Hills, Ohio held Tuesday
September 4, 2018 at 8:46 p.m. in the
Village Hall Council Chambers at 7595 Walton Road

Location of Meeting: Council Chambers

Mayor Kolograf called the meeting to order. The roll call was taken by Katie Iaconis, Fiscal Officer. Present: Councilpersons Mary Brenner-Miller, Jennifer Allen, Gloria Terlosky, Denny Linville, Fred Neilsen, and Brian Spitznagel. Mayor Kolograf makes a note that Fiscal Officer Katie Iaconis and Law Solicitor William Mason are present as well.

Ordinance 2018-13. Mr. Mason announces Ordinance 2018-13, an ordinance amending Chapter 230 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Walton Hills and declaring an emergency. Councilman Spitznagel makes a motion to amend Ordinance 2018-13 to strike any reference to a pay decrease for the Mayor. Seconded by Councilman Linville. Six ayes approve. Councilman Spitznagel introduces Ordinance 2018-13 for suspension, an ordinance amending Chapter 230 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Walton Hills, Ohio, and declaring an emergency. Seconded by Councilman Linville. Six ayes approve. Councilman Spitznagel clarifies why he made that motion. The ordinance that the council has is already struck out, but in the previous one that was put out, it did not. So, we amended it to pass this one. Councilman Spitznagel asks for adoption of Ordinance 2018-13. Seconded by Councilman Linville. Five ayes and one nay.

Ordinance 2018-14. Mr. Mason announces Ordinance 2018-14, an ordinance authorizing and directing the Fiscal Officer to certify delinquent property maintenance and trash collection assessments to the county auditor for collection and declaring an emergency. Councilwoman Terlosky introduces Ordinance 2018-14 for suspension, an ordinance authorizing and directing the fiscal officer to certify delinquent property maintenance and trash collection assessment to the county auditor for collection and declaring an emergency. Seconded by Councilman Spitznagel. Six ayes approve. Councilwoman Terlosky ask for adoption of Ordinance 2018-14. Seconded by Councilwoman Brenner-Miller. Six ayes approve. Councilwoman Terlosky clarifies that we are currently being billed for trash collection, but in the future, it will be on the taxes. That is why it is an assessment. Katie verifies this.

Councilwoman Brenner-Miller makes a motion to adjourn the September 4, 2018 Special Council Meeting at 8:52 p.m. Seconded by Councilman Linville. Six ayes approve. Mayor Kolograf adjourns the meeting at 8:52 p.m.
