

Minutes of a Special Council of the
Village of Walton Hills, Ohio held Tuesday
May 8, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the
Village Hall Council Chambers at 7595 Walton Road

Location of Meeting: Council Chambers

Mayor Hurst called the meeting to order. The roll call was taken by Katie Iaconis, Fiscal Officer. Present: Councilpersons Mary Brenner-Miller, Jennifer Allen, Gloria Terlosky, Don Kolograf, Denny Linville, and Councilman Spitznagel. Mayor Hurst also wants the record to reflect that our law solicitor William Mason and Katie Iaconis as our Fiscal Officer and Clerk of Council.

LEGISLATION:

Ordinance 2018-9. Councilman Linville introduces Ordinance 2018-9, an ordinance amending Section 514.035 C1, A, and B of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Walton Hills and declaring an emergency. Seconded by Councilwoman Brenner-Miller. Mayor Hurst states that the packet that they have some typo errors in them so there is a refreshed one in front of them with corrected documentation. Councilwoman Allen asks why we are doing this on an emergency basis when we have only had the cameras up for one month. Discussion ensues on this between the Mayor and the council members. No further comments or questions. Six ayes approve.

Resolution 2018-18. Mayor Hurst explains that this is the resolution to put a moratorium on small cell towers that was passed at the state level. Councilman Kolograf asks for an explanation on what a moratorium is and what this does for us. Mr. Mason explains what this is and what this does for us. A small discussion ensues. Councilman Kolograf introduces Resolution 2018-18 for suspension, a Resolution declaring a 12-month moratorium on the granting of building permits for small cell facilities and wireless support structures within the right-of-way in the Village of Walton Hills, and declaring an emergency. Seconded by Councilwoman Terlosky. Six ayes approve. Councilman Kolograf asks for approval of Resolution 2018-18. Seconded by Councilwoman Terlosky. Six ayes approve.

Mayor Hurst asks for a motion to adjourn the Special Council Meeting. Councilman Kolograf makes a motion to adjourn the May 8, 2018 Special Council Meeting. Seconded by Councilman Linville. No questions or comments. Six ayes approve. Mayor Hurst adjourns the meeting at 6:24 p.m.
