Several local farmers would frequently provide them with fresh meat and produce as a way of saying thanks for saving their land in the great fire of '22. Using culinary skills that he picked up while serving in the navy, Firehouse #8 had comfort food that Tony Maloney elevated to a level previously unheard of at the time.




