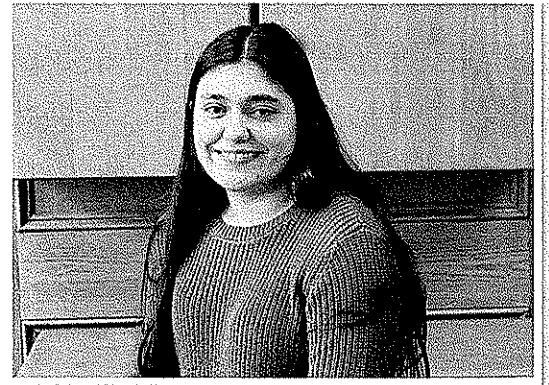
Basic Facts About the Tuition Program
